

OFFICIAL RULES

EDP ROCK 'N' ROLL MADRID 1/2 MARATHON



ART. 1

COMPETITOR SPAIN, S.L. (C.I.F. B86053006) with a registered office in Lexxel services, Doctor Fleming, 3 – 9, Madrid and the SPORT ASSOCIATION MAPOMA (CIF G78184678), with a registered office in c/ Donoso Cortés 54 28015 Madrid, organizes the EDP Rock 'n' Roll Madrid ½ Marathon 2018, that celebrates the city of Madrid on the 22nd of April 2018. The race will start at 8:55 and end at 12:05.

The Half Marathon is run in a completely urban area with a distance of 21.097m, it has been officially recorded and proven by the Real Federación Española de Atletismo (R.F.E.A)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: : this race follows the official calendar of the Real Federación Española de Atletismo and through this the runner consents that all of their basic information can be used for processing purposes by the company, the insurance company, the compulsory insurance of accidents and civil responsibilities like the day of license management and popular ranking of the route tests. In all cases and as stated in the law of Protection of Data, the runner can exercise in the future their rights of access, rectification, cancelation, and written opposition, via letter or email, to the Real Federación Española de Atletismo. ART. 2

There will be two races that follow the path of the ½ Marathon, they have different classifications and are independent of each other.

- **Elite Race:** They will leave at 8:55 AM and this race is reserved only for athletes that have been invited by the organization and to those athletes signed up for the race who have credit for a time faster than 1:07:00 for men and 1:20:00 for women within the past three seasons (the dates of these races have to have come after the 31st of October 2014). In order to receive credit for these times, it is necessary that before the 8th of April 2018, you send the results from the race in which you eclipsed those times to inscripcion.elite@mapoma.es. The time will only be considered valid if the race was included in the official calendar of the IAAF, AIMS, or RFEA.
- **The Popular Race:** They will leave at 9:05 AM and it is reserved for the rest of the participants.

ART. 3

The maximum time of the race will be three hours. The Finish Line closes promptly at noon.

ART. 4

Following the norms of the IAAF, there will be a refreshment station every 5Km.

ART. 5

The circuit is completely blocked off from traffic, and the only vehicles that can follow the race are designated by the organization. The municipal police can expressly sanction vehicles and bikes that are not authorized to be on the race premises.

ART. 6

All participants should be in possession of a federal license or a license of a plus runner, given by the RFEA (Real Federación Española de Atletismo), on the day of the race. Some participants who previously were at the race without possession of a federal license or a plus runner card received from the RFEA, can acquire a federal license for a day from the organization during the process of signing up for the Marathon.

ART. 7

All those who have signed up are covered by a policy of accident insurance, covered by the organization through the RFEA (Real Federación Española de Atletismo), this covers the accidents that could come as a direct consequence of participating in the race, and not from a pre-existing condition, or injury, also imprudence, negligence, and not following of the rules and articles of the rulebook, etc. Also travel incidents to and from the race are not covered.

ART. 8

In agreement with the rulebook of the R.F.E.A (Real Federación Española de Atletismo), the following categories will be used for the breakdown of the placement, and standings. It is broken down by gender and year born.

Category	Age Group
A (Junior)	Born in between 01/01/1999 and 04/22/2000
B (Promises)	Born in between 01/01/1996 and 12/31/1998
C (Senior)	Born in between 04/23/1983 and 12/31/1995
D (Veterans M35/W35)	Born in between 04/23/1978 and 04/22/1983
E (Veterans M40/W40)	Born in between 04/23/1973 and 04/22/1978
F (Veterans M45/W45)	Born in between 04/23/1968 and 04/22/1973
G (Veterans M50/W50)	Born in between 04/23/1963 and 04/22/1968
H (Veterans M55/W55)	Born in between 04/23/1958 and 04/22/1963
I (Veterans M60/W60)	Born in between 04/23/1953 and 04/22/1958
J (Veterans M65/W65)	Born in between 04/23/1948 and 04/22/1953
K (Veterans M70+/W70+)	Born before 04/23/1948

ART. 9

The timing for this race will be done through the BibTag of MYLAPS system, for this reason it is MANDATORY that you use this chip system. There will be timers at the start, the middle, and 7 more stations to collect your time and pace throughout the race. You will go through each of these, so it is crucial you follow the Chip rules, as well as the regulations and route of the race.

ART. 10

YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF:

- You do not pass through all the established checkpoints
- You do not do the full route
- If you change or alter the workings of the chip
- If you wear a chip meant for a different runner
- You don't wear the properly assigned Dorsal chip edition for this specific race
- Enter the finish line without a chip
- If you do not follow the rules of the organization or the judges

*You lose your right to all prizes if you are disqualified

ART. 11

The organization publishes official provisional placements and times on their website on the 22nd of April; claims can be made at this point if they arise.

All of the classifications of the competition are unique and exclusively of the members of the committee of justices for the R.F.E.A. for any claim over the classifications or time, you can follow this process in the established protocol for this function on the official page of results for the race before 8PM of the Friday following the race. The organization will send the decisions of the Referee Judge within a window of 7 days, the pending result will from the Referee Judge will be final and definitive.

ART. 12

The first three men and three women who finish the elite race will receive a trophy, as well as the first five men and five women who finish the popular race will receive a trophy. Also trophies will go to the first three men and women of each category in the popular race.

ART. 13

At 12:30 at the finish line, the trophies will be handed out on the podium to the top 3 finishers in men and women for the elite race.

The trophies corresponding to the popular race, will be available in the in the halls of the MAPOMA office from the 15th of May to the 31st of May. If it is not picked up within these days you forfeit your right to receive the trophy.

OTHER PRIZES

The runners who place 1-25 in men and women for the popular race will get a free registration to the EDP Rock 'n' Roll Madrid 1/2 Marathon for the 2019 race.

ART. 14

All of the participants, in order to finalize your registration accept the following rules and give your consent for MAPOMA for their own, for their sponsors, or for third party entities, to treat your information specifically for sport, promotional, or commercial use, such as your personal data, like your images during a race, videos, etc. following the established organic law 15/1999 of the 13th of December, of the protection of personal data, the participant has the power to exercise their right to access these files with the object of rectifying or canceling a partial or total form of the content they are used in. IMPORTANT:

The runners who place first through 25th men and women in the popular race will get the EDP Rock 'n' Roll Madrid Marathon & 1/2 registration fee covered free of charge for 2019.
